

Diplomat Mark Brzezinski was sworn in as the new US ambassador to Poland

Brzezinski previously served in the administration of Barack Obama and was US ambassador to Sweden from 2011 to 2015. From 1999 to 2001, he served on President Bill Clinton's National Security Council, first as a director for Russia and Eurasia, and then as a director for the Balkan. Brzezinski, who speaks Polish and French, was a Fulbright scholar in Poland and is the author of *The Struggle for Constitutionalism in Poland*.



He is the son of the late Polish-born Zbigniew Brzezinski, who served as US national security adviser under President Jimmy Carter and was a holder of the Order of White Eagle, Poland's highest state honour.
