

## SYDNEY EXTENDS COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS

10.05.2021

The NSW Government has had to extend restrictions for an additional week even though there was no



recorded of locally acquired cases of Covid. Most of the restrictions will stay in place across all of Greater Sydney, Wollongong, Blue Mountains and the Central Coast until at least 17.05.2021. The Government has advised that as of Monday customers for retail and hospitality venues will be able to do their shopping without a mask but retail staff must still adhere to wearing a mask. Is this such a good idea at the moment, time will tell. The NSW Premier Gladys Berejiklian has thanked the public for all their patience while trying to find the missing link. The following measures will begin as of midnight 17.05.2021.

- Visitors to households are limited to 20, this includes children as well as adults
- Wearing of masks is compulsory on all public transport and indoor public venues such as theatres, hospitals and aged care facilities
- Masks are not required in gyms or similar facilities like indoor pools or dance studios
- Drinking while standing at indoor venues is not allowed
- No singing is allowed whatsoever
- Dancing is not permitted at indoor hospitality venues or nightclubs; however, dancing is permitted at weddings with no more than 20 people on the dance floor at any given time
- Only two people are allowed to visit per day at aged care facilities
